I. The Babylonian Conquest and Daniel's Intervention

1. Marduk as Ba'al (Gilgamesh)

- •Marduk was the chief deity of Babylon during the time Cyrus conquered the region.

1. Enki as the Great Serpent-Dragon (Ushumgal)

- •Enki, known as Ushumgal (♣►, "Great Serpent-Dragon"), was one of the three horned serpents of Akkadian mythology.
- •Enki was worshipped in Eridu, where serpent-shaped artifacts were found in his temple.
- •He was associated with wisdom, water, healing, and creation.

2. Enki as Prometheus, the Bringer of Knowledge

- •Just as Prometheus gave fire to humanity, Enki was responsible for teaching humans arts and knowledge.
- •The "Tree of Knowledge" and "Tree of Life" motifs appear in Enki's hymns, similar to the Biblical serpent.
- •Enki's association with trickery and shapeshifting aligns with Loki (Norse) and Prometheus (Greek).
